Hands on Stamps: United States 1962—National Apprenticeship Program

On August 31, 1962, United States issued this commemorative stamp (Fig. 1) to mark the twentyfifth anniversary of the National Apprenticeship Act ("Fitzgerald Act") and honor the National Apprenticeship Training Program.
